## Please submit the following application documents:

- 1. A **letter of intent**, stating the reasons for your application as well as an explanation of why your dissertation is not suited for electronic publication
- 2. A **summary** of your dissertation (max. 5 pages)
- 3. A curriculum vitae in table form (max. 2 pages)
- 4. A **copy of the official certificate** of your **successful completion** of the Rigorosum/Disputation including the final grade
- 5. Price quotations from two publishers and an explanation of your choice of publishers

Please submit your application to the Dean's Office of the Faculty in which you were registered as a doctoral student. Applications must be submitted in paper and electronic form (a <u>single</u> PDF-file on CD).

Please note that the grant funds can be paid out only within the calendar year 2012. This means that successful applicants will be required to submit proof of the publication of their dissertation to the Graduate Academy at the latest by the end of October 2012.
